Each candidate will memorize and perform a two-minute monologue. The monologue **<u>must be from a published play only</u>**. (No poems, original works or screenplays will be accepted.) The monologue is worth 0 to 50 points:

Each candidate will participate in an improvisational group to assess skills in collaboration and spontaneous use of movement and speech to create a character in a particular situation. The improvisation portion of the audition is worth 0 to 15 points:

Movement	10
Redirection	10
Overall Presentation	10

Each candidate will provide the adjudicator with a resume. It should be neat and organized, including personal information and theatrical experience. The resume counts for 5 points.
